Model United Nations (also Model UN or MUN) is an organization similar to the United Nations in which students from different countries of the world participate (0) as delegates to various committees. The participants of MUN range (1) _____ middle school students to graduate school students.

MUN holds annual conferences in (2) _____ students research and formulate political positions based (3) _____ the actual policies of the countries they represent.

The committees in the Model UN are similar to those in the actual UN and they cover similar areas including human rights, education, environment etc. There is also (4) _____ special committee that does not have a parallel in the actual UN. It deals (5) _____ the issue of crisis and is called a 'Crisis Committee.' Here, student teams concentrate (6) _____ a single crisis (fictional or non-fictional) and must come up (7) _____ solutions.

In order to maintain coherence, MUN conferences have rules of procedure which guide the conference delegates in their work. Since there is (8) _____ single governing body for MUNs, each conference may differ (9) _____ the rules of procedure – some conferences may apply the UN rules directly and faithfully, while others may adapt those rules.

Each committee has a Chair (also called a Moderator) (10) _____ main task is to enforce the rules of procedure. A delegate may request the committee to perform a particular action; this is known (11) _____ a motion. Documents aiming to address or resolve the issue of the committee (12) _____ called resolutions and must be voted for (13) _____ the delegates.

MUN committee meetings are divided (14) _____ three sessions: formal, moderated, and unmoderated. In a formal session, there is (15) _____ list of speakers and the delegates follow the order of the list. Delegates talk to the entire committee: they make speeches, answer questions, and discuss the issues. In a moderated session, anyone may speak (16) _____ allowed by the Chair / Moderator of the committee. In (17) _____ unmoderated session, the delegates meet with other delegates and the staff for informal discussions.

MUN conferences are not limited (18) _____ any country or continent, but are spread worldwide. The locations include: North America, Europe, Asia, Latin America, the Middle East, and Africa.
